#### THE REPEAL OF NET NEUTRALITY



It is not too late to contact your Congressional representatives and make your plea to reinstate Net Neutrality, letting them know how important free and open access to the Internet is to our communities.

# MONTGOMERY HIGHER EDUCATION CONSORTIUM RESEARCH FORUM

The Montgomery Higher Education Consortium comprises of a group of academic institutions that support Higher Education in the vicinity of the Montgomery, AL area. The Consortium was formed in May, 1997 to support and share resources among member institutions through reciprocal borrowing/lending of materials for a set time period by students and faculty of these institutions. The members of the MHEC are Alabama State University, Auburn University Montgomery, Faulkner University, Huntingdon College and Troy University Montgomery. Each library has its own procedures with regards to borrowing and returning of materials.

The idea of Montgomery Higher Education Consortium Research Forum was initiated in 2014 by the Deans and Directors of the MHEC member Libraries. The Forum meets once a year in December at one of the member Libraries. The first year that the Forum had an event was in December, 2015. The Forum's focus changes every year with the new trends in the profession. Proposals are presented by the Librarians and staff from these libraries with regard to the chosen theme for the year during the event. So far, there have been three forums and all of them were hosted by the Levi Watkins Learning Center at Alabama State University.

The planning committee for the Research Forum includes Librarians from each of the libraries in the Consortium. The committee meets in June to start planning for the event in December. The committee discusses various ideas and frames the theme for the year which is then forwarded to the Deans of the Libraries for their approval.

After the theme is approved, proposals are solicited from member libraries starting August through October. A deadline is determined to give the committee time to review the proposals and select those relevant to the theme for presenting in December. Once the proposals are reviewed by the committee, the presenters are informed about them so that they can work on their presentations. In addition to proposals, posters are also an option for the Forum which are usually presented during the break time of the event.

The event sometimes has a guest speaker who is not a member of the Consortium but has a good knowledge and ties to the Profession. The program is set usually for 2.5 hours with a short break for refreshments. There were five presentations with a few minutes of Q&A after each presentation and two poster sessions during the break time at the 2017 December event.

The Forum has been very successful with attendance increasing across the years. Originally the event was only for the MHEC Consortium libraries but other Academic Libraries in town were also invited. In FY2017, invitation was extended to Tuskegee University and some Librarians attended the Forum.

Participation for presentations has also increased consistently since the initial Forum three years ago with more Librarians as well as staff from the various Libraries taking the opportunity to share their ideas and information. The Research Forum is a good avenue for Librarians interested in sharing their Research presentations to a small group with good insight and get their input in the form of question and answer session. It is also a good opportunity for staff attending Library School to present during these sessions as it is a learning/sharing their experiences scenario which will help them to have a better understanding of the profession.

The Forum hopes to see more participation and attendance in the coming years and incorporate more ideas and changing trends of Librarianship as part of the focus for the Forum every year.
